Deputy Director of Public Health

This is a professional, administrative position involving the responsibility for planning, organizing and supervising public health services for the St. Lawrence County Public Health Department. The Deputy Director is responsible for the direction and supervision of the daily operation of programs and services as assigned and would act as Director in his/her absence. Supervision is exercised over Public Health staff. The incumbent is responsible for assisting in the promotion of community health and health maintenance by ensuring safe, effective and efficient departmental services and prevention programs. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Public Health Director with wide leeway allowed for the use of independent judgment in carrying out work activities. The incumbent does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: either:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Master's degree in public health, nursing or closely related field and four (4) years of administrative experience in a public health agency, hospital or health related program;
OR
- B. Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's degree in public health, nursing or closely related field and six (6) years of administrative experience in a public health agency, hospital or health related program.
