Office for the Aging Temporarily Closing Congregate Dining Centers

Effective 3/12/2020, the St. Lawrence County Office for the Aging is temporarily closing all congregate dining centers for the next few weeks. All home delivered meal clients will continue to have meals delivered. Congregate clients will be contacted by Office for the Aging staff to discuss their food options.

This measure is being taken out of an abundance of caution to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus amongst those 60 and above. Older adults are the highest risk level group and should use caution when attending large gatherings. There are still no confirmed positive cases in St. Lawrence County as of this posting.
