- Fish fingerlings are bagged with oxygen. **The hatchery charges \$1.00 per oxygenized bag on the day of pickup (CASH ONLY).** The number of bags you will need is dependent upon the size of your order and transport time.
- Please bring something to hold the bagged fish upright and stable during transport. A pail or cooler will work well.
- You should obtain a free State Fish Stocking Permit from DEC, application attached.
- Please be on time! A schedule of pickup times will be given via telephone, generally the hatchery arrives about noon. If you are not available to pick up your order at the scheduled time, please make arrangements for someone to do so for you. Orders not picked up on time will not be held.
- The District is not responsible for the survival of the fingerlings during transport or after placing in waterbody.
